ECFA Launches Presidential Search as Dan Busby Transitions to Emeritus Role

WINCHESTER, Va., Oct. 14, 2019— In preparation for Dan Busby's transition to president emeritus, anticipated by the spring of 2020, ECFA is beginning the search process for a new president. Busby proactively approached ECFA's board in early 2018 to initiate succession planning. Busby, age 78, communicated his desire and commitment to position the next generation of leadership to successfully advance the mission and purpose of ECFA.

During Busby's 12 years as president, ECFA's membership has grown from 1,260 to nearly 2,400 accredited churches and Christian ministries. ECFA's church membership has grown from only a few dozen to nearly 250 churches, including 48 of the 100 largest churches in the U.S. In his new role, Busby will continue to actively assist in advancing the work of ECFA.

"Dan is an incredible leader who has grown ECFA's membership and increased its influence among the evangelical community in our country and around the world. Dan's legacy will linger in the valuable resources he developed that serve ministry leaders and pastors in their efforts to operate above reproach," said Danny de Armas, ECFA board chair, "He is loved, admired and respected, and I'm pleased that he will continue to contribute to ECFA's work. We have faith that God will lead us to the person who will build on Dan's amazing legacy."
