Hi Rob.

Thank you very much for the phone conversation Tuesday. I appreciate the gracious way you listened and asked clarifying questions. After thinking it through I'd like to offer some specific options in response.

Regarding the public apology

I heard you when you said the leaders of CRPC offered public apologies in various services and on several occasions and I was glad to hear you did that. This apology would be much more specific to my situation as I can only speak for myself.

Options - From the pulpit. Letter to the congregation. Letter to the leaders and/or all of the women in the ministry at the time (via snail mail). Letter on the website. Via social media or a way to direct it toward Liberate/Dropping Keys communities.

Regarding the monetary demonstration

This is awkward to talk about because, as I said, I am not making any demand whatsoever. But hopefully this will help to organize your thoughts around where to start and what might make sense.

Options - I believe these are some of the items we talked about on our call. I estimated the Knox tuition, I'm not sure of the exact tuition fees from 2014. The estimate is based on two more classes I took in the Spring and Fall of 2014 (Dollar amount is based on 1/3 of course total). I also estimated an amount for counseling because of your honesty about your own counseling and how helpful it was for you and Jen. It's something I should have done years ago after all that went down. I am sure it would have been of value as I tried to get through that difficult period and beyond.

I can only imagine all you witnessed and heard during your time there, and I completely understand how you would have considered leaving ministry altogether. I hope you both found the healing and closure you needed from that painful period of ministry.
