
## Standard of Proof

## **Opinion Summary**

It is my opinion, taking into account all direct and circumstantial evidence, and applying the preponderance of evidence standard, that it is more likely than not that on or about October 24, 2012 in San Diego, California, that after initially agreed to have sex with Braylon Oliver, when she told him to "Stop, [that ]he was hurting her," Braylon refused to stop, and covered her mouth to keep her quiet and continued the act over her clear objections.
