
I am responding to the request you made on April 11, 2023, for certain documents identified below. As you are aware, the Coronado Police Department is a division of the City of Coronado, which is subject to the Public Records Act under Government Code 7921.000 *et seq.* Any documents in the City's possession are subject to this Act. The following are the documents you requested:


1. Information about an incident that occurred on Wednesday, March 22.

This letter shall constitute our determination made pursuant to the California Public Records Act. In accordance with Evidence Code Section 1040, Penal Code Sections 832.7 and 832.8, and Government Code Sections 7922.535(a) and (b), 7922.600-605, 7927.705 and 7922.540, we have determined that the City is in possession of responsive records; however, some of those records are exempt from disclosure. There was a police investigation regarding the records that you have requested, specifically related to an incident occurring on March 22, 2023. Police investigative files and official information are privileged and confidential pursuant to California statutory and case law. *See, e.g., Cal. Gov. Code 7922.600-605; Cal. Evid. Code §§1040 and 1041; the Information Practices Act of 1977 (Cal. Civ. Code §§1798, et seq., including 1798.40 and 1798.41); and City of Orange v. Superior Court (2002) 79 Cal.App.4th 759, 764 ("Evidence gathered by police as part of an ongoing criminal investigation is by its nature confidential.")* The confidential nature of police investigative files continues in effect after an investigation is concluded. *See Williams v. Superior Court (1993) 5 Cal.4th 337, 354-55.* Accordingly, those parts of the police investigative file as of March 22, 2023, through the conclusion of the investigation that contain officer impressions or are otherwise privileged and confidential are being withheld on that basis.
