CERTIFICATION FOR DETERMINATION OF PROBABLE CAUSE

That [REDACTED] is a Detective with the City of Kirkland Police Department and has reviewed the investigation conducted in Kirkland Police Department Case Number: 19-9542. There is probable cause to believe that [REDACTED] committed the crime(s) of:

RCW 9.44.060 Rape 3rd Degree

This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

On 03/22/19, [REDACTED] came to the Kirkland Police Department and reported a sexual assault to Officer DePauw. [REDACTED] stated that on 03/02/19 at about 2345 hours, she, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in the parking lot of her apartment complex, [REDACTED] Kirkland drinking alcohol. All three met through the Churchome College. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] brought the alcohol and [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was encouraging them to take bigger "Swigs from the bottle". [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] why he was not drinking as much as them and he stated that he was not feeling well. At one point, [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] touched her crotch area and she told him no and he stopped. After a few hours of drinking, they decided to go to [REDACTED] apartment, [REDACTED] had to help [REDACTED] inside due to her being highly intoxicated. They all three went into [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]'s room.

[REDACTED] was also very intoxicated and a bit unclear of what happened. She remembered [REDACTED] being either next to her or on top of her in her bed. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] began vomiting so [REDACTED] carried her to the bathroom. [REDACTED] crawled to the bathroom to vomit and remembered [REDACTED] telling her to put her pants on. At some point, [REDACTED] called another friend, [REDACTED] to help him clean up the vomit. [REDACTED] stated that he arrived at the apartment and everyone was in the bathroom. He said there was vomit everywhere and [REDACTED] was lying in the bathtub and [REDACTED] was on the floor. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] shirt was off and she was only wearing a bra and leggings. He stated that [REDACTED] shirt and pants were off and she was only wearing a bra and panties. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were heavily intoxicated and [REDACTED] seemed sober. He and [REDACTED] put [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] back into the beds and he called [REDACTED] to come home. He and [REDACTED] left and went to his house, where they spent the night.

The next morning, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met at [REDACTED] apartment.

██████████ shared that ██████████ told him ██████████ said the night before "don't rape ██████████ rape me." ██████████ just laughed at this comment. ██████████ and ██████████ took ██████████ to work and asked him if anything happened and he told them no. The next day they again asked ██████████ if anything happened and he again said no.

On 03/06/19, ██████████ was feeling vaginal discomfort, so ██████████ and ██████████ decided they needed to talk to ██████████ and met him at a coffee shop. They again asked ██████████ what happened and he asked ██████████ what she thought happened. ██████████ told him she didn't remember and that's why she was asking him. ██████████ told them ██████████ was sleeping and he had fingered ██████████ but that she had asked for it. When ██████████ threw up ██████████ said he stopped.

██████████ and ██████████ gave ██████████ a ride back to the apartments and ██████████ asked ██████████ to tell her again what happened. This time ██████████ said ██████████ was trying to push him off her and they "messed around." ██████████ asked what that meant, and he said he "fingered" her, and they messed around. This is the last time ██████████ spoke with ██████████ who had moved back to Connecticut.

██████████ stated that a month prior to this incident she was in ██████████ car with a bunch of people, again drinking. She said ██████████ dropped everyone else off and it was just the two of them in his vehicle. ██████████ said he tried to "finger her" and she did not think it was okay, but it happened anyway. She told ██████████ that she did not want to go any further than that and he pulled down his pants and he kept going until she started to cry.

On 3/14/19, ██████████ was in Arizona and went to the gynecologist, due to still having vaginal discomfort. On 3/18/19, she was advised that she had chlamydia. ██████████ stated that she had not had sex with anyone for a couple of years and believed she contracted chlamydia from ██████████. ██████████ said the incident has affected her eating, sleeping and she quit her job. ██████████ stated she wanted to pursue criminal charges against ██████████.

On 07/01/19, ██████████ was interviewed at the Danbury Police Department by Detective ██████████. In the interview, ██████████ stated that in the beginning of March 2019, ██████████ and ██████████ wanted to get together with him before he left Washington. He said the two picked him up and drove to ██████████ apartment complex. ██████████ stated that ██████████ was 21 and provided them with 2 bottles of alcohol that they drank in the parking lot of ██████████ apartment complex. After a few hours, ██████████ got drunk and ██████████ had to help her to ██████████ apartment. While in the car, ██████████ stated that ██████████ told him that they were both attracted to him. As ██████████ helped ██████████ up to the apartment he said ██████████ wanted to kiss him and he told her he did not think so because she was really drunk. In the apartment, he helped ██████████ onto ██████████ bed, and ██████████ laid on her bed. ██████████ stated that he laid on the floor in the room, but ██████████ told him to sleep in her bed. He got into ██████████ bed and soon

after they began kissing. [REDACTED] stated that they were both wearing clothes and he reached his hand inside [REDACTED]'s pants and began touching her vagina just on the outside. He said he never penetrated her vagina nor had sex with her. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was verbally consenting throughout the encounter. In addition to [REDACTED] consent, [REDACTED] stated that she had her hand on his groin area. [REDACTED] stated that they did not have sex, because [REDACTED] started throwing up and it was gross. He also stated that they both had to get out of bed to help [REDACTED] into the bathroom because she vomited on herself.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had told [REDACTED] ex-girlfriend [REDACTED] that he had sex with [REDACTED] and she contracted chlamydia from him. [REDACTED] in turn, confronted [REDACTED] about the accusation. [REDACTED] told her he did not have sex with [REDACTED] and did not have chlamydia. [REDACTED] went to Planned Parenthood and was tested for chlamydia with negative results.

[REDACTED] denied ever having any type of sexual contact with [REDACTED]

Detective [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if he had any other prior interactions with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that around October 2018, he had kissed [REDACTED] while in his vehicle. He said [REDACTED] was uneasy about the kiss, because he had just started a relationship with [REDACTED] and the two were friends. Detective [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] disclosed that he had "fingered" her that time in the vehicle. [REDACTED] denied that occurred and speculated that [REDACTED] lied about the incident to try and "volumize" or bolster her claim by adding things to her account.

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had been expelled from the college program, because she had broken the rules of the school. He said [REDACTED] was allowed to remain in the school because "she was the victim of the situation". [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] approached [REDACTED] in an effort to change the policies of the school to get [REDACTED] back into the program.
