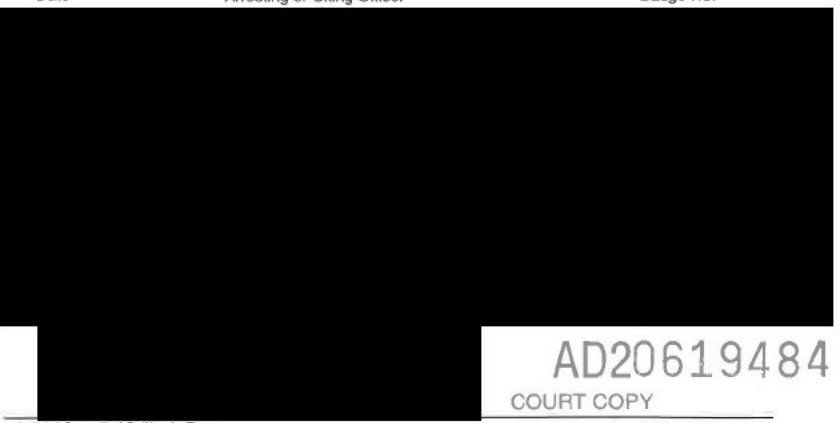

1 On November 25th, 2017, I was on full uniformed patrol in Tehama County, when I was contacted by Warden  
 2 Carlson regarding a CalTIP from [REDACTED]. The CalTIP reported an  
 3 individual had possibly been hunting within 150 yards of an occupied dwelling and shooting from a vehicle. At  
 4 approximately 1040 hours, [REDACTED] and I met with the reporting party (RP) to obtain a  
 5 statement. The RP requested to remain anonymous.

6  
 7 It was determined the subject of the CalTIP, later identified through dispatch as John Christopher Feucht, had  
 8 possibly committed the above violations, as well as trespassing on private property. The RP heard two shots  
 9 coming from [REDACTED] at approximately 0730 hours. The RP then observed Feucht pick up what  
 10 she believed to be a bird. Feucht then ran back to his house. The RP then observed Feucht driving an off-road  
 11 vehicle northbound on Quail Valley Road before stopping and firing a third shot into the open field on the west  
 12 side of Quail Valley Road. Feucht then turned the off-road vehicle around, ran into the field, and picked up what  
 13 the RP believed to be two birds. Feucht then drove back to his property.

14  
 15 At approximately 1150 hours, [REDACTED] and I arrived on Quail Valley Drive north of Shadow  
 16 Hill Lane. I located one unexpended blue shotgun shell off the roadway on the west side of Quail Valley Drive. I  
 17 photographed and seized the shotgun shell as evidence. Approximately 25 yards west of the shotgun shell, I  
 18 located a pile of feathers approximately 10 feet wide. Between the shotgun shell and the pile of feathers there  
 19 was a no trespassing sign. I determined the feathers belonged to a wild turkey. I photographed the pile and seized  
 20 two samples of the feathers, one from the west side of the pile, and one from the east side of the pile.

21  
 22 At approximately 1220 hours, I located a pile of turkey feathers on the northwest corner of the property at [REDACTED]  
 23 [REDACTED]. I photographed the pile. At approximately 1240 hours, I attempted to contact the property  
 24 owner at [REDACTED]. I determined the owner, Feucht, was not home. I spoke with Feucht's  
 25 babysitter and obtained his name and phone number. The babysitter stated Feucht had killed one turkey that  
 26 morning, and showed me a picture Feucht had posted on Instagram that morning of him holding a turkey (See  
 27 Attachment A). I located one fresh turkey leg on the property, next to a dog food bowl. I photographed the turkey  
 28 leg.

29  
 30 At approximately 1300 hours, I attempted to call Feucht twice. I left a voicemail instructing Feucht to call me  
 31 back as soon as possible. While parked on Stillwater Road, [REDACTED] and I were contacted by an  
 32 individual later identified by his California hunting license as [REDACTED] who asked if we were in the area  
 33 because of the turkey that was killed that morning. It was determined [REDACTED] and Feucht were friends. Feucht  
 34 had asked [REDACTED] to speak with us after Feucht learned we had been to his property. [REDACTED] stated he was the  
 35 owner of the off-road vehicle Feucht had used, as well as the shotgun he had used. [REDACTED] had let Feucht borrow

36 both items the previous day. Eriksen allowed me to look at both items. I located turkey feathers in the cargo bed  
37 of the off-road vehicle. I photographed and seized a sample of the feathers. I located one expended shotgun shell  
38 underneath the driver's seat of the off-road vehicle. That shotgun shell matched the unexpended shell I had  
39 located on Quail Valley Road earlier. I photographed the shotgun shell.

40

41 I examined Eriksen's shotgun, a Remington Versa 12 gauge shotgun, serial number: RT17719B. I photographed  
42 the shotgun and returned it to Eriksen. Eriksen offered to show us the text messages from Feucht asking to  
43 borrow the shotgun and off-road vehicle. While viewing those messages, [REDACTED] observed a text  
44 message from Feucht asking Eriksen not to tell Fish and Wildlife about the feeder he had on his property. When  
45 asked about the feeder, Eriksen stated Feucht had a feeder located near his house. Eriksen further stated that  
46 Feucht has had issues with turkeys damaging his property, causing him to move the feeder farther away from his  
47 house. Warden Carlson asked Eriksen to call Feucht and tell him to call my work phone.

48

49 At approximately 1400 hours, I received a phone call from Feucht. Feucht gave me the following statement: At  
50 approximately 0730 hours that morning, he had fired two shots at a turkey located on the northwest portion of  
51 his property. He wounded the turkey, but did not have any more ammunition in the shotgun. He ran back to his  
52 house, got in the off-road vehicle, and drove to Quail Valley Road. He observed the turkey he had wounded was  
53 now in the open field on the west side of Quail Valley Road. He stopped the vehicle, stepped out, and fired one  
54 more shot at the turkey. The turkey died as a result of this shot. He turned the vehicle around, ran into the field to  
55 retrieve the turkey, and then drove back to his house. He stated he had not seen any signs in the field at that time.  
56 He stated he had only shot and killed one turkey. He said no one else had been hunting on his property that  
57 morning. He stated the feeder was up the hill on the other side of the property from where he shot the turkey. He-  
58 stated the feeder was for rabbits he had released on his property. He told me the feeder contained corn. I arranged  
59 to meet with Feucht at 1100 hours at his property the following day to see the turkey and speak with him in  
60 person.

61

62 I used Google Earth to examine Feucht's property and determined the entire property was less than 400 yards in  
63 all directions. By hunting on his property with a feeder containing corn, Feucht was in violation of California  
64 Code of Regulations Title 14 (CCR T14) 257.5 -  
65 Hunt within 400 yards of bait. (See Attachment B)

66

67 On November 26th, 2017, at approximately 0930 hours, I contacted the original RP for a follow-up interview. I  
68 told the RP what Feucht had told me. The RP stated they were not certain that Feucht had shot more than one  
69 bird. They also stated they were unsure if Feucht had shot while sitting inside of the off-road vehicle, or while  
70 standing on the roadway. The RP confirmed Feucht's statement regarding how many shots had been fired and  
71 the locations they were fired.

73 At approximately 1050 hours, [REDACTED] and I arrived at Feucht's property. He told me he had processed  
74 the turkey and left the unused portions of the body on the property he owned on the south side of Shadow Hill  
75 Lane. Feucht told me what location on his property he had been on when he fired the first two shots. He  
76 reiterated that the feeder he had was for five rabbits he released onto his property. He stated that the rabbits were  
77 wild. He also told me where the feeder was located and that it contained corn. Whole corn kernels are not  
78 regularly used as feed for rabbits, and can be harmful to rabbits. Due to my training, I know corn is commonly  
79 used as bait for turkeys.

80  
81 He stated he placed the feeder approximately one week earlier and had not moved it. Feucht stated he did not  
82 know it was illegal to hunt within 400 yards of a feeder. [REDACTED] asked Feucht why he told Eriksen not  
83 to tell Fish and Wildlife about the feeder. Feucht denied sending the text message. He stated he believed it was  
84 unlawful to shoot deer near bait, but did not think it was illegal to hunt turkey near bait.

85  
86 I located the turkey carcass and photographed it. I located the feeder and photographed it. The feeder was a  
87 Moultrie tripod feeder, which is advertised by Moultrie as a deer or wildlife feeder. Using GPS coordinates taken  
88 by my department issued phone, I determined the feeder [REDACTED] was located  
89 approximately 113 yards from the pile of turkey feathers ([REDACTED] I located on Feucht's  
90 property (See Attachment C). I photographed and seized corn that was located on the ground underneath the  
91 feeder. I determined Feucht was in violation of Fish and Game Code (FGC) 3004(a) - Hunt within 150 yards of  
92 an occupied dwelling, and CCR T14 257.5 - Hunt within 400 yards of bait.

93  
94 I issued Feucht a citation for CCR T14 257.5 - Hunt within 400 yards of bait. I gave him a verbal warning for  
95 FGC 3004(a) - Hunt within 150 yards of an occupied dwelling.

102 Except as otherwise provided in these regulations or in the Fish and Game Code, resident game birds and mammals may not  
103 be taken within 400 yards of any baited area.

104 (a) Definition of Baited Area. As used in this regulation, "baited area" shall mean any area where shelled, shucked or  
105 unshucked corn, wheat or other grains, salt, or other feed whatsoever capable of luring, attracting, or enticing such birds or  
106 mammals is directly or indirectly placed, exposed, deposited, distributed, or scattered, and such area shall remain a baited  
107 area for ten days following complete removal of all such corn, wheat or other grains, salt, or other feed.
