

RELEASE ORDER

State of Minnesota vs Jason Christopher Yates

Parties Present:

Jason Christopher Yates; State of Minnesota and
Hannah Martin

The defendant shall meet with the Department of Corrections to allow them to fully complete a presentence investigation with a psychosexual evaluation is ordered to be completed prior to sentencing. The defendant is ordered to fully participate in both evaluations and is additionally ordered to sign any releases necessary for the Department of Corrections agent. The defendant may sign a release for probation to access the psychosexual evaluation already complete. If probation determines it does not meet their requirements, the defendant shall comply with new psychosexual evaluation.

IT IS ORDERED THE DEFENDANT SHALL BE RELEASED UPON THE FOLLOWING:

Sign all releases of information; for jail, law enforcement or probation
Complete booking
Keep court/attorney informed of current address
Released on own recognizance
Remain law-abiding
Make all future court appearances
No contact with females under age 14
Not Possess/Use Any Pornographic/Sexually Explicit Material; Must have approved software on

phone or any internet capable device to prevent pornographic material
Post Bail or Bond with No Conditions; \$100,000.00

IF YOU VIOLATE THIS ORDER:

- You could be arrested;
- Your bond or bail could be forfeited;
- You could be charged with a new crime; and/or
- You could be held in contempt of court.

The terms of this order will remain in effect until another court order changes or vacates this order, until you are found not guilty of the criminal charges in this case, until the criminal charges against you are dismissed, or until the sentencing in this case.
